Authorisation requirement according to goods list item 2D002 Annex I of the Dual-Use Regulation



An authorisation requirement may also arise via other connecting factors such as sanctions list screening, country control or purpose of use control. The present information only describes the acquisition according to goods list item 2D002 Annex I of the Dual-Use Regulation.

Software for electronic components, whether or not permanently stored in an electronic component or system, which enables such components or systems to perform numerical control functions capable of coordinating more than four interpolating axes simultaneously for contouring control.

The acquisition of the numerical KEB control systems according to the goods list item 2D002 is dependent on the CNC High End software component.

Numerical control systems subject to authorisation

As a part of the configuration, the CNC high-end software component is defined that coordinates more than four interpolating axes simultaneously to the path control for control systems requiring authorisation.

Authorisation free numerical control systems

For authorisation-free numerical control systems, there is an authorisation-free CNC High End software component (export variant), which is limited to four interpolating axes.

Marking of the authorisation requirement

The numerical control systems covered by goods list item 2D002 Annex I of the Dual-Use Regulation are marked accordingly on the relevant business documents such as offer, order confirmation, invoice and delivery note.
